- 1. Introduction
- 2. Believe fundraiser update
  - a. Total earned was \$5,300
  - b. The check will arrive 5 days after shipment of items to the school
  - c. Shipment of items to school came in today Dec 5th
    - i. Items purchased
    - ii. Prizes for students who sold items
  - d. We qualified for \$500 shopping spree by signing up early last year
    - i. Must use by end of this month
    - ii. Could use for Teacher appreciation in May or cookies for next conference meal
    - iii. Mystery kitchen items are half-off
      - 1. Probably won't be able to buy items for all teachers but could raffle off prizes in a fun way
    - iv. Melissa will purchase
- 3. Play in a Week (Great Theater)
  - a. Possibly will do district-wide
  - b. If so, Great Theater will offer discounted rate of \$1,000 (last year cost was \$4,500)
  - c. School will have to pay, but this is very doable especially if we sell tickets for a donation
  - d. Derek has conference call with district officials tomorrow to help sell the idea
  - e. Need to nail down:
    - i. Dates available in March, April, May
      - 1. Targeting week of March 13-17
      - 2. Play would be on Friday night (early)
    - ii. Supervision
      - Derek will find out if this needs to be licensed teacher and/or staff member
      - 2. Lyndsay or Melissa could possibly do
      - 3. If non-licensed staff, school can compensate
  - f. Play mostly 5<sup>th</sup> grade but can open it up to 4<sup>th</sup> grade if there is room
- 4. Teacher requests for funds and budget update
  - a. Derek's misc requests
    - i. Good quality Kleenex
      - 1. If purchased through district, it is generic and poor quality
      - 2. Will need about 100-150 boxes
    - ii. School is going through lots of printer paper too 30 boxes in first trimester
    - iii. PAW will do a supply drive in January

- Reems of paper, Kleenex, extra school supplies like crayons and markers
- 2. Next year we should look at purchasing these items at beginning of school year when they are cheaper
- iv. 4<sup>th</sup> grade seeking supplies for winter family board project
  - 1. \$60-\$75 will provide boards for entire grade-level
  - 2. PAW approves, will come out of budget
  - 3. Teachers buy and submit form for reimbursement
- b. Teacher/Staff requests
  - i. Kindergarten Ginger-Bread Houses
    - 1. Two projects: Stand up felt person and cookie decorating
      - a. Cookie pricing
        - i. Cold Spring Bakery = 6 dozen for \$54
        - ii. Dutch Maid has 17 dozen for \$80
    - 2. Needs \$134.62
    - 3. Approved, will come out of budget
    - 4. Melissa will get frosting, M&Ms, plastic knives
  - ii. EL Ginger Bread Houses
    - 1. EBD and EL are currently combined in PAW budget
    - 2. Need to give each department their own budget
    - 3. There are 2 EL teachers and 80 EL kids
    - 4. EBD/EL combined has \$150
    - 5. Should bump EL to at least \$200
    - 6. EBD should go with SPED
    - 7. SPED has \$150 PAW budget + building budget
    - 8. Can this go into effect this year?
      - a. Budget already set for this year, but we can make adjustment if EL goes over
  - iii. Sweatpants for nurse
    - 1. Several families have donated
    - 2. Melissa plans to purchase additional pairs from Once Upon A Child
- 5. Ideas for spending some money
  - a. If we do well with Coin Wars, we may get close to max budget
    - i. Can't go over \$50K
  - b. PAW focused on providing experiences
  - c. Currently no field trips planned so want to get ideas from teachers on experiences
  - d. Will create a form for teachers to submit ideas for experiences and send out in January
    - i. Need to give them a due date maybe mid-February
  - e. Derek will talk to teachers at next leadership meeting
  - f. Experience ideas
    - i. Raptor Center free if certain percent of school qualifies for free/reduced lunch. Westwood is 47-51%, not sure if it would be free but we could still pay
    - ii. Game day in classroom
    - iii. Yoyo Guy
    - iv. Hemker Zoo
    - v. Magician
    - vi. Penguins
- 6. Beaver Island Tending for Cause
  - a. Took in \$224 from raffle
  - b. Beaver Island will pay all tips and \$1/pint sold

- c. Waiting on check, expected within 6-8 weeks coming up on 8 weeks
- d. Derek will follow up with Meredith tomorrow

### 7. Apparel

- a. Melissa has not heard from Felicia about doing apparel fund raiser
- b. Looking at doing in January, Derek will follow up
- c. \$1,700 from last year's sales is still in bank account
  - i. Planned use playground equipment
    - 1. Replacement is very expensive and taking a while to figure out
  - ii. Could possibly use money for Robotics
